THINGS TO GATHER

Sticks

Secateurs

Wire and pliers

Small pine cones

Holly

Pine needles

Small bells

String or wool

Scissors

Find six sticks and trim them to the same length using the secateurs. Make a triangle with three of the sticks and secure the corners with wire, using the pliers to tighten. Repeat with the other three sticks so that you have two triangles.

Lay the two triangles over the top of each other in opposite directions and secure together using the wire and pliers in at least three places where they overlap.

Decorate the star by attaching small pine cones, holly, pine needles or small bells with colourful wool or wire.

Use the stars as Christmas tree decorations, tie them to presents, hang one on your front door or in a window, or make many stars and create a decorative hanger.
